

Junior High Youth Group Frequently Asked Questions

When is Junior High Youth Group?

- Junior High Youth Group is select Wednesdays, 3:30-5:15pm in the Youth Room at Peace. When your Youth arrives, they should ring the doorbell (the white pill-looking button on the door frame) to be let in.

Who can come to Junior High Youth Group?

- Junior High Youth Group is for 6th-8th graders. If a Youth wants to bring a friend or family member, they can if they are in that age range.

Where should I drop off my Youth?

- Please drop off your Youth at the door marked "GYM" on the West Side of the building. Youth enter and exit that door.

What can my Youth expect at Junior High Youth Group?

- When Youth arrive they have time to hang out, do homework, play Mario Kart, and eat snacks. We have a full fridge of soda & water and chips and snacks. We play a lot of games at Junior High Youth Group. Games vary in energy level. After games we talk about how the game applies to our faith. We usually start playing games around 4:00pm. Youth are signed in and out by an Adult Leader. When Youth arrive, we will ask who is picking them up.

When does Youth Group end? What does pick-up look like?

- Junior High Youth Group ends at 5:15pm. An Adult Leader brings the kids to the door marked "GYM." When they see their pick-up person, they let the Adult Leader(s) know, then they leave. If the weather is nice, we do the same procedure only we are outside.

Who are the Adult Leaders?

- For the 2021-2022 school year, the Adult Leaders for Junior High Youth Group are Blake Brockman, Vicar Jacob Sipes, and Kezia Musolff. If you are interested in being an Adult Leader, please talk to Blake.

What COVID19 precautions are you going to take?

- We understand that there are differing opinions on what to do with COVID19. We are thankful to God that we did not have any issues with COVID last year and pray for the same this year. Masks are optional and hand sanitizer will be available for use.

They do not need to be members of Peace Lutheran Ministries to come to Youth Group!
- **Offer to give rides!**
 - Some Youth want to come, but do not have a ride. Encourage your Youth to ask their friends if they need a ride to & from Youth Group!
- **Donate snacks & drinks!**
 - While we do budget for things like snacks & drinks, donations are extremely helpful! We ask that snacks are Nut-Friendly!
- **Become an Adult Leader!**
