**INCLUDED IN PRICE:**

- 1) Round trip airfare per brochure — deluxe motor coaches — First Class / Superior Class hotels — guided sightseeing — entrance fees to sites visited — breakfast & dinner daily per brochure — One Lunch
- 2) Taxes and fuel charges totaling **\$595** USD comprised of **\$264.60** for fuel charges (subject to increase by airline up to 30 days prior to departure) and **\$330.40** for taxes (including federal inspection fees for the U.S. Customs and Immigrations; international air transportation tax; agricultural tax; other per person taxes imposed by government entities; airport taxes and fees including the September 11th Security fee up to \$10 per person, passenger facility charges up to \$18 per person, federal domestic flight segment fees up to \$3.50 per segment and U.S. and International arrival and departure, and other government imposed fees up to \$300 per person).

**NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE:**

Not included in your package are passports, visas, COVID-19 tests, vaccinations, laundry, lunches per brochure, telephone, mini-bar, alcohol, other beverages, and food outside of the contracted tour operator menu as presented at a hotel or restaurant (these extra items will be billed to you before leaving the hotel, or restaurant), airport transfers on non-qualifying flights, portage at airports, travel insurance, excess baggage fees, any fees or fuel surcharges imposed by the airlines after the date you register for your trip, items of personal nature and all other items not specifically mentioned.

**PAYMENT:**

A full deposit of \$500 per person is required at time of registration. Credit cards are only accepted for the initial deposit. **All other remaining payments must be made in the form of a check, including final payment.** Final payment is **due no later than 100-days prior to departure.** Registrations received after 100-days prior to departure must be accompanied by full payment. Registrations received between 90-75 days prior to departure are subject to a \$300 late fee.

Tour pricing is based on a minimum group size of 20 passengers to be valid. *The following supplements may apply for smaller groups:* 19-15 travelers, \$150 per person; 14-10 travelers, \$195 per person. If group size is less than 10 travelers, the tour may be canceled due to lack of participation. **If final (full) payment is not received by Imagine Tours and Travel, LLC (hereafter referred to as Imagine) 75-days prior to departure, you will be automatically cancelled from the tour and your initial deposit of \$500 will be forfeited and additional fees may apply.** Imagine reserves the right to add a surcharge if the dollar declines by more than 2% against the shekel or euro based on foreign exchange rates in effect on date (10/24/23) when your tour was booked by your tour leader/church. **All payments are required in US Funds.**

**ACCOMMODATIONS:**

Price is based on double occupancy (two persons sharing a room). When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. While Imagine will try to match roommates, we cannot guarantee one will be available. Roommates may be assigned as late as 75 days prior to departure. If one is not available or if you request a single room, there will be a **single room supplement charge of \$945 for the basic itinerary; \$395 for the optional Jordan extension.**

**ITINERARY & CHANGES:**

Because airlines often change flight schedules after brochures are printed, Imagine reserves the right to shorten or lengthen the itinerary accordingly. You will be notified in writing when possible. If itinerary changes necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged \$195 per night/per person (single rooms \$225/night). Meals for extra nights are not included. **Any changes and/or deviations from the program and/ or departure city listed, by the passenger, must be provided in writing to Imagine no later than 100-days prior to departure and any extra costs incurred will be billed to the passenger.** All deviations are subject to a standard fee of \$150 plus any applicable airline fees. **All tours are final at 70-days prior to departure. No changes and/or additions may be made to the tour after that time.**

**LAND ONLY:**

**Land Only price is \$3,752 per person. Price does not include international flights.** Land Only passengers may be responsible for transfers and/or additional overnights incurred by booking their own flights. We recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties, as the group's flights may change. Passengers changing from the regular tour to Land Only after 120 days prior to departure will be charged a fee of \$150 per person.

**AIRLINE TICKETS:**

In order to keep prices low, **Imagine does not guarantee you will be on the most direct flights to your final destination. Imagine also does not guarantee the group will be on the same flights, particularly if registering 100 days prior to departure.** Flight routings are chosen by the airlines and not Imagine. Airline tickets cannot be changed or refunded once issued. Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more flying together for entire itinerary. Imagine is unable to use individual frequent flyer points to upgrade or accept them as partial payment for air transportation. Deviations by the passenger, from the group's scheduled flights, could result in different routings/air carriers. Airline changes, if allowable, made by the passenger after final payment has been made, may incur additional fees.

**FLIGHT TIMES:**

**All flight times are subject to change by the airlines without advance notice. Imagine is not responsible for such changes or delays and does not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays.** If making your own flight arrangements to a departure city or any other portion of your trip, we recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties. All passengers are responsible for reconfirming their flights with the airline 24 hours prior to departure.

**PASSPORT:**

Each passenger is responsible for making sure that they have a **valid passport that has an expiration date at least six months after the date of return from their trip.** A copy of your valid passport must be submitted to our office by 100 days prior to departure.

**VISAS:**

Applicable visas will be obtained by Imagine for U.S. and Canadian Citizens only. All passengers who do not carry U.S. or Canadian Passports will be responsible for obtaining visas to the countries they are visiting. Imagine is not responsible for non-U.S. & Canadian Passport holders.

**TRIP RESCHEDULING:**

Imagine and/or Trip leader reserve the right to re-schedule the dates of the Trip to future dates TBD due to governmental action, pandemic, or other circumstances beyond their control. Should that occur, all travelers will be rebooked for the new dates. Travelers unable to travel on the new dates may cancel their participation and will be assessed a cancellation fee of up to \$300 per person, plus any additional penalties/fees imposed by ground operator(s), airlines, or other vendors. Travelers can transfer to another available tour up to one year from their original departure date.

**CANCELLATION FEES:**

Any passenger cancelling from the day of registration to 100 days prior to departure will be charged a **\$300 non-refundable administrative fee** per person plus any airline penalties, if applicable. You will also be charged a single room fee if your cancellation forces your roommate into a single room from 75 days prior until the date of departure. The following charges also apply: 99-75 days = **\$500**; 74-55 days = **\$2,750**; 54-41 days = **85% of total cost**; 40 days to day of departure = **100% of total cost. All cancellations must be received in writing. On or after the day of departure there is no refund for any services not used. We strongly recommend you purchase travel insurance.** If Imagine cancels the tour due to lack of participation, there will be a charge of \$200 deducted from the amount refunded to each passenger for administrative fees plus any airline penalties if applicable. No changes may be made to the tour within 70-days of departure, as the tour is officially closed.

**Day 1 – Monday, January 13: Depart U.S.A.**

Tour members meet for our flight to Israel. After dinner is served, it's time to sit back, relax, and enjoy the on-board entertainment to prepare for this exciting adventure of a lifetime.

**Day 2 – Tuesday, January 14: Arrive in Tel Aviv**

In Tel Aviv, we proceed through customs and security and meet our guide who assists us to our motor coach. We have a short drive to our hotel in the Netanya area in time for our special welcome dinner and overnight.

**Day 3 – Wednesday, January 15: Caesarea, Megiddo, Mt. Carmel, Nazareth Village, Cana, Galilee**

This morning, we depart for the Galilee to visit Biblical sites at Caesarea Maritima, where Peter proclaimed the Good News to the Roman Centurion (Acts 10). We also see Megiddo and Mt. Carmel, where Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18). Time permitting, we'll stop at the Druze Village for a short lunch break (not included). We continue to Nazareth (Luke 1 & 2- the church with the springs that Mary came to) to visit the "Nazareth Village" with detailed explanation of what life was like during the time of Jesus. We also visit Cana (John 2) on the way to Tiberias for dinner and overnight on the shore of the Sea of Galilee.

**Day 4 – Thursday, January 16: Golan Heights, Caesarea Philippi, Tel Dan Seven Springs, Mt. of Beatitudes, St Peter's Primacy Church, Capernaum, Boat Ride, Boat Museum, Magdala**

There is nothing like watching a sunrise on the Sea of Galilee from our hotel. After breakfast, we travel north to the Golan Heights for a beautiful view of northern Israel's landscape. Then we will head to Caesarea Philippi where Peter confessed, "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God" (Matthew 16:13- 16). We embark on a short hike to Tel Dan to see the altar of Jeroboam. For lunch, we'll enjoy an included box lunch while overlooking the Sea of Galilee. Afterwards, we make our way to the Mt. of Beatitudes (Matthew 5-7), with time for reflection and worship. Then we visit Capernaum (Jesus' base for His early ministry). Next, we board a replica wooden "Jesus Boat" for our boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. We conclude our sightseeing with a visit to the new Magdala archaeological site, which is rich in cultural history for both Jews and Christians. Afterwards, we see Gadara, followed by dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

**Day 5 – Friday, January 17: Mt. Arbel, Jordan River, Gideon Springs, Beit Shean, Jerusalem**

We begin our sightseeing with a drive up to Mt. Arbel for an overlook of the Sea of Galilee. Time permitting, we will have a stop in Bethsaida. Then we make our way to the Jordan River and have the opportunity to step into that special river before heading to Gideon Springs (time permitting, we will have a short stop at Nain on the way). Next, we visit Beit Shean, one of the best-preserved Decapolis Roman cities. This is where King Saul and his sons' bodies were hung from the city walls after being defeated by the Philistines (1 Samuel 31:10-12). Finally, we ascend to the majestic city of Jerusalem in time for dinner and overnight. "I was glad when they said to me, 'Let us go to the house of the Lord.' Our feet are standing within your gates, O Jerusalem" (Psalm 122:1-2 NASB).

**Day 6 – Saturday, January 18: Wadi Kelt, Bethany by the Jordan, Ein Gedi, Qumran, Masada, Dead Sea for Swim / Float**

After breakfast, we begin our sightseeing as we drive to the Wilderness. The road from Jerusalem to the Dead Sea region is a decent of 4,000 feet in 13 miles. Our first stop will be at Masada, where we take a cable car up to the fortress built by King Herod. Here we survey the ruins of fortifications, waterworks, the synagogue, temples, and palaces. Next, we drive to Ein Gedi where David hid from King Saul. A short drive takes us to Qumran and the settlement of the first century sect known as the Essenes, authors of the Dead Sea Scrolls. Afterwards, we follow the road south along the western shore of the Dead Sea (the lowest spot on earth) where we will stop for a short swim. Time and conditions permitting, we'll include a short visit to Jericho. Dinner and overnight are in Jerusalem.

**Day 7 – Sunday, January 19: Mt. of Olives, Palm Sunday Road, Garden of Gethsemane, Jewish Quarter, Temple Mount, Southern Steps, Church of the Holy Sepulchre, Solomon's Quarry**

We begin the day with worship on the beautiful Mt. of Olives to behold the breathtaking panorama of the Holy City. Our pilgrimage will proceed down the Old Palm Sunday Road to the Garden of Gethsemane with its ancient olive grove, and the Church of Agony, where tradition holds that Jesus prayed. We will walk to the holiest site in the whole Jewish world, the Western

(Wailing) Wall of Herod's temple. Beyond the wall lies the 35-acre temple area purchased by King David (2 Samuel 24:18-25). On this site now stands El-Aksa Mosque, and the magnificent Dome of the Rock (the third holiest shrine in Islam). There will be a few hours for lunch (not included) and exploration on your own. We make our way to St. Stephen's Gate, to walk the Via Dolorosa, including St. Anne's Crusader Church, Pools of Bethesda, the Pavement (where Jesus stood while being tried by Pilate), Ecce Homo Arch, and the ancient Cardo. We continue to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. A short walk takes us to stand on the original steps that Jesus walked on as he entered the Temple area. We will have dinner and overnight in Jerusalem. If time permits, we will visit Solomon's Quarry or visit the Museum at the Notre Dame Jerusalem Center, which hosts the Shroud Exhibition.

**Day 8 – Monday, January 20: City of David, Hezekiah's Tunnel, Pool of Siloam, St. Peter Galllicantu, Shrine of the Book, Model City, Garden Tomb, Western Wall Tunnels**

This morning, we visit the Shrine of the Book Museum to see the Dead Sea Scrolls and the fascinating 1:50 scale model of Jerusalem as it would have appeared in Jesus' time. Next, we drive to the City of David, an incredible archaeological find. Afterwards, we take a short walk to Hezekiah's Tunnel (conditions permitting). Be sure to bring a flashlight and water shoes to walk through the tunnel. Anyone wanting to stay dry can walk through Hezekiah's shaft. If time permits, we will visit the newly excavated Pool of Siloam. Next, we see the Church of St. Peter in Galllicantu. We end our day with worship and communion at Golgotha and the Garden Tomb. Dinner and overnight are in Jerusalem. After dinner, we have a visit to the Western Wall Tunnels.

**Day 9 – Tuesday, January 21: Bethlehem, Herodium, Elah Valley, Jaffa, Farewell Dinner, Ben Gurion Airport**

We begin our day with a visit to Bethlehem and a visit with Pastor Mitri Rabeb at Christmas Lutheran Church to learn about their ministry (provided he is in country during the time of our visit). We pass by Rachel's tomb on the outskirts and visit the Church of the Nativity and Shepherd's Field. In Bethlehem, we visit an olive wood factory and shop. Then we drive to Herodium. This "palace-fortress" built by King Herod (Matt. 2) is located on the edge of the Judean Desert, where he would be eventually buried. Afterwards, we will visit Bethany (conditions and time permitting). Then we depart for the Elah Valley to see the brook where David slew Goliath. From here, we continue our drive to Jaffa for a special Farewell Dinner. We then transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for our flight back to the U.S.A.

**Day 10 – Wednesday, January 22: Arrive in U.S.A.**

We arrive back in the U.S.A. at the close of an unforgettable tour. We take home wonderful memories of the Old and New Testament, a renewal of our faith, and a greater understanding of the life of our Lord.

**Day 10 – Wednesday, January 22: Allenby Bridge, Jordan: Madaba, Machaerus, Petra**

This morning we depart Israel for Jordan via the Allenby Bridge, where we meet our agent and are assisted through security and customs. We board our motor coach to Madaba, the Moabite town of the Bible to see the Ancient Holy Land Map. Next, we travel to Machaerus (Mukawir). Perched on a 700-meter- high hill southwest of Madaba are the ruins of the fortress of Herod the Great. Machaerus is where John the Baptist was beheaded by Herod Antipas. We continue south to Petra, "the Red Rose City." Dinner and overnight are in Petra.

**Day 11 – Thursday, January 23: Petra, Amman**

After breakfast, we visit Petra, a 2000-year-old Nabatean city. We'll walk about a half-mile through the narrow passageway with cliffs on either side (called the "Siq"). At the end of the Siq appears Petra's Treasury, a massive royal tomb carved out of the solid mountain rock. Time permitting, we will see Jabal Harun - the place where Aaron is buried. We then leave in the afternoon for Amman. Dinner and overnight are in Amman.

**Day 12 – Friday, January 24: Amman, Mt. Nebo, Allenby Bridge, Israel: Jaffa, Tel Aviv Airport**

This morning we travel to Mt. Nebo to view the Holy Land from where Moses stood (Deuteronomy 34:1), a breathtaking view across the Jordan Valley and the Dead Sea to the Mt. of Olives and the roof tops of Jerusalem. We then return to the Allenby Bridge for our return to Israel. After our border formalities, we arrive back in Israel and continue with a visit to Jaffa. Then we have dinner and an evening transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for our return flight back to the U.S.A.

**Day 13 – Saturday, January 25: Arrive in U.S.A.**

We arrive home in the U.S.A. At the close of an unforgettable tour, we take home wonderful memories of the Old and New Testament, a renewal of our faith, and a greater understanding of the life of our Lord.
